授業内容 Course Description	This class will introduce students to qualitative methods of research in the social sciences. Our emphasis in the first half of this class will be on the gathering of data. We will experiment with structured interviews, unstructured or informal interviews, oral histories, narratives, group interviews, biographies, observations, participant-observations, documentary records, and organizational and community studies. The second half of the semester emphasizes methods of analyzing, theorizing from and writing results from such data. Towards the middle of the semester, after experimenting with various methods of data collection, students select a project (and a partner) of their choosing and proceed to collect and (later) analyze these data, leading to the production of a draft report.						
到達目標 (授業の狙い) Objectives	We will consider four major issues especially relevant to qualitative research methods: 1) an introduction to questions of epistemology in social research; 2) an introduction to strategic logistical and ethical concerns in the conduct of research: 3) the relevance of personal characteristics?one's own and informants?in the conduct of research; and 4) appropriate methods of data collection.						
授業方法 Method of Instruction	The class will consist mainly of discussions of the readings and designing, debriefing, and critiquing of student exercises and activities. Students' active participation in class discussion is mandatory: I expect students to share their experiences and materials with peers, and to provide helpful feedback and critiques to one another.						
準備学習 Class Preparation	Three different kinds of written assignments are required: 1) structured exercises to provide you with experience in gathering data; 2) copies of materials and field notes as you work on your original research project; 3) An original research project (with a partner) utilizing two or more of the data gathering methods discussed in class.
