授業内容 Course Description	<p>This course surveys selected works of pre-modern Japan from the seventh through the eighteenth centuries and discusses relevant art historical issues as well as the cultural environment of art production. Each work we will focus on represents and epitomizes a different historical period with its distinct subject matter and visual culture. 授業方法 Method of Instruction	The classes fundamentally consist of lectures which will almost always be illustrated and supported by visual aids such as slides, films, and replicas of certain art works.		
準備学習 Class Preparation	Students are expected to prepare for class by reviewing their notes from previous classes. They should review and memorize basic information about each art work as well as proper terms that have been introduced in previous lesson. When reading is required for preparation, reading materials will be provided in advance. Estimated required time to prepare for class is approximately 20 minutes.
